If I could go into the past I would like to unravel the hidden knowledge of Mohenjo Daro. I often wonder that, Mohenjo Daro was an urban civilization even 5000 years ago. Here are some points on this Ancient Indus Civilization.

- The ancient city of Mohenjo Daro is one of the first Urban Center in Human history.
- Nestled in southern Pakistan's Indus river valley Mohenjo Daro is the largest and best preserved city of the Indus Valley Civilization.
- The earliest known civilization of the Indian sub continent is Indus Valley Civilisation.
- 4. Mohenjo Daro was built around 2500 BC. About the same time the great pyramids were being built in Egypt and expand a surface area of nearly 500 Acres, an incredible size for a city of this time period.
- 5. Because of Mohenjo Daro's grand scale, archeologists believe it may have served as a seat of power for Indus Valley Civilization.
- The city was divided into two districts, the Citadel and the Lower Town.

Citadel

- The Citadel is home to the city's exceptional monuments including the great bath, a 900 square foot fed from the Indus River.
- 2. Mohenjo Daro also had a sophisticated water system. Houses had baths, toilets and the town featured both an elaborate sewage system and fresh water system in 700 wells!
- Mohenjo Daro has no places of worship or governance such as palaces, royal tombs or temples.

Lower Town

- Lower Town may demonstrate the societies egalitarian structure.
- 2. The population of lower town was between 20000 to 40000 people.
- 3. Unlike many urban areas of its time, it was laid out in a grid system similar to modern day city blocks. Even after 600 years of the collapse of the city, no one knew the reason behind the collapse. In 1950, after 4000 years archeologists began their excavation and rediscovered the abandoned and ruins of Mohenjo Daro.

Even though, excavations have told us many things, still it holds many secrets for us to discover.


