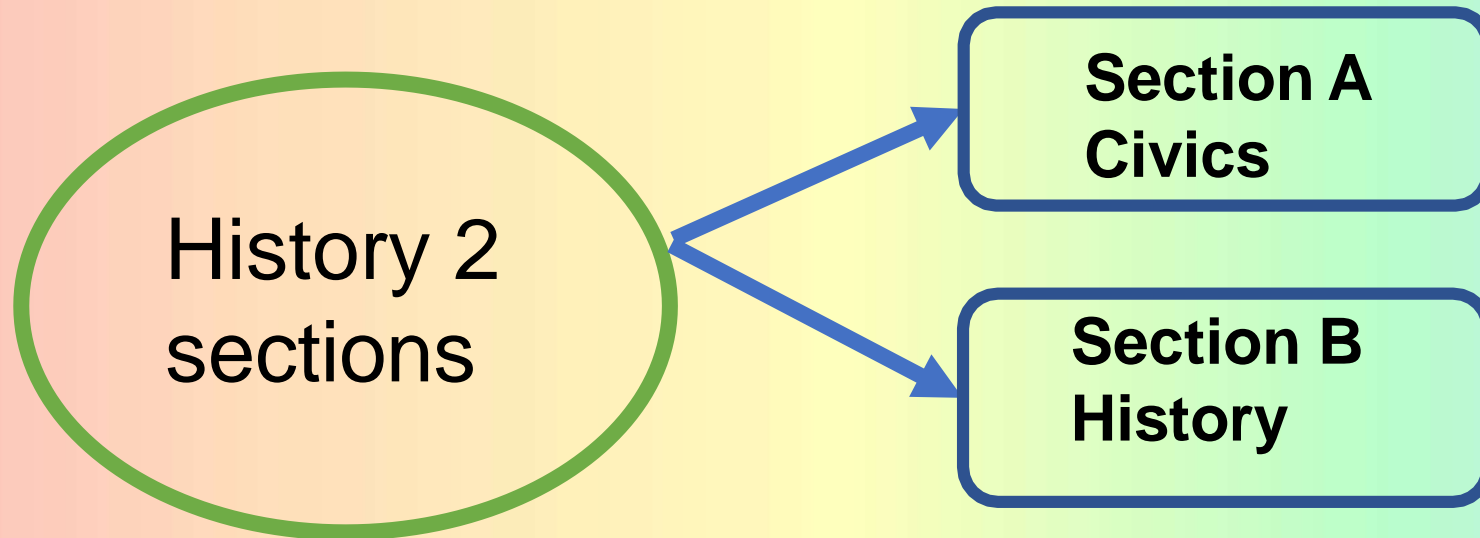

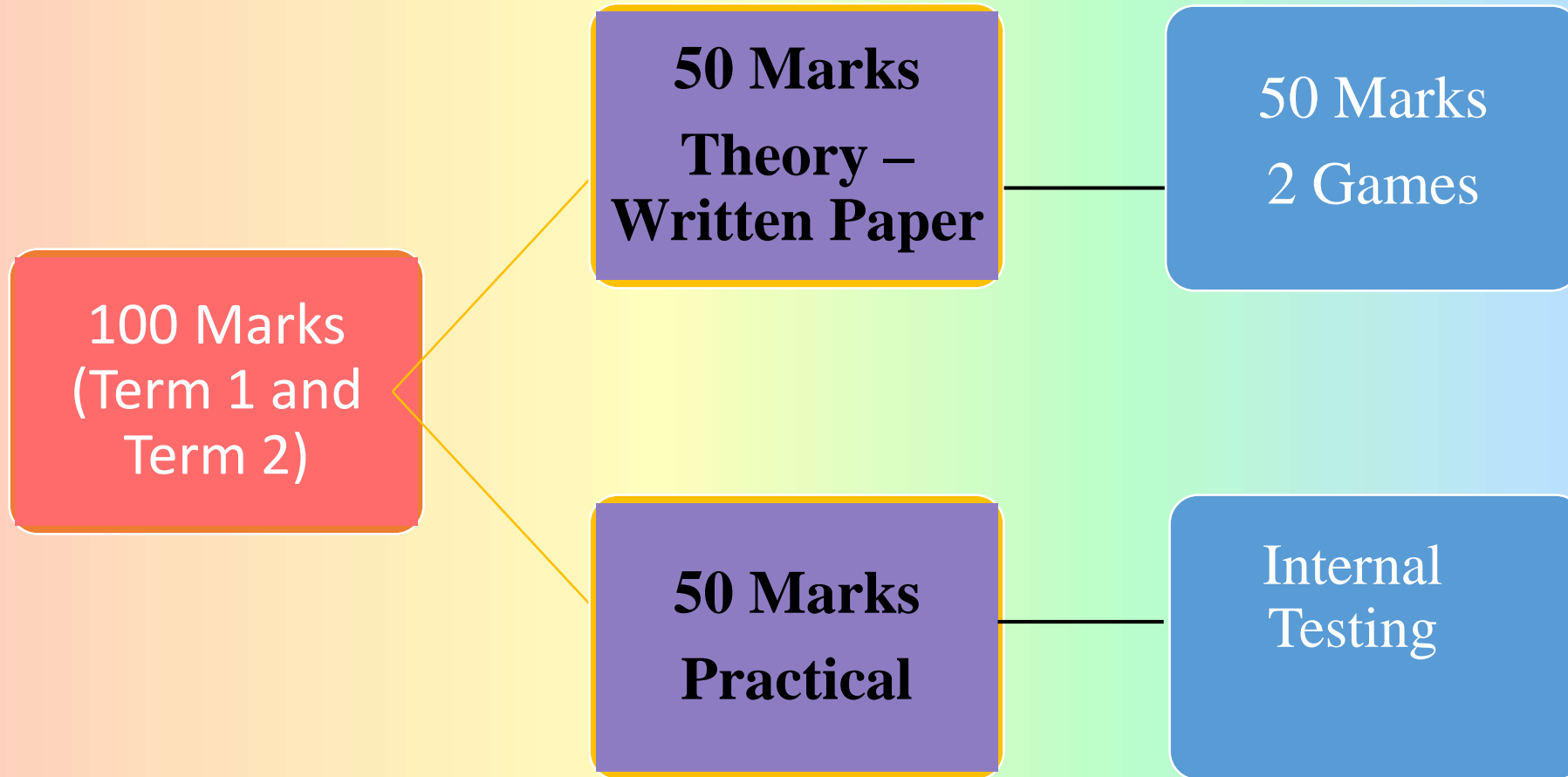

IMPORTANT

Promotion Criteria

- **Students must score a minimum of 35% in the External Assessment and 35% in the Internal Assessment in each subject, to be promoted to Grade 9.**
- **Additionally, they need to have an attendance of minimum 75% for promotion.**



Subject Selection Criteria (For the admission of Grade 9)

- **Mathematics** - Students must score a minimum of **60%** in the **Mathematics External Assessment (Written examination)** in each examination **(Unit and Term)** in order to choose the subject **Mathematics** in Grade 9.
- **Computer Application** - Students must score a minimum of **60%** in the **Computer External Assessment (Written examination)** in each examination **(1st and 2nd Term)** in order to choose the subject **Computer Application** in Grade 9.



Points to be remembered....

- Grade 8 is a **promotion year**. If a child is unable to meet the passing marks criteria he or she will be detained in Grade 8.
- No Retest will be conducted.
- The final examination for Grade 8 will be conducted in the month of January 2027.
- The new academic session **2027-2028** will begin in **February, 2027**

General Instructions

- You need to **update your child's Adhaar card** before the admission.

- Reduce the screen time for yourself and your children.
- Encourage outdoor games.



General Instructions

- Punctuality and regularity is very important to follow-
 - Children should be punctual and regular.
